PROUDLY EMPOWERING WOMEN IN DEFENCE INDUSTRY

Developed in 2015, The Future Through Collaboration (TFTC) Mentoring Program is an award-winning, industry-lead, not-for-profit initiative designed to support the professional development and capacity building of women in defence industry.

TFTC delivers a structured program that provides mentee women working across STEM functions with access to their own defence industry mentor for a period of 12 months. More than 350 mentees have participated in the program representing more than 20 different organisations.

The 2024 program launches on the 29th of August 2024 and runs to the 31 August 2025.

Applications open 29 April 2024 - 3 June 2024.

YOUR COMMITMENT

- Complete the application form and phone interview.
- Dedicate~1 hour a month for one-on-one mentoring sessions.
- Attend the 1/2 day induction & launch session in September.
- Attend three 2hr quarterly meets in November,
 March, and June.
- Arrange any necessary travel to sessions.

FORMAL MENTORING OPPORTUNITIES HOW THE PROGRAM WORKS

All mentees and mentors participate in an induction training session to ensure that they get the most out of the program. Mentee and mentor pairs meet monthly one-on-one and also attend quarterly facilitated peer group training sessions to support their ongoing success. The program's formal training is delivered by Leading Well, an organisation specialising in leadership, business coaching and mentoring programs.
