Developed in 2015, The Future Through Collaboration (TFTC) Mentoring Program is an award-winning, industry-led, not-for-profit initiative designed to support women's professional development and capacity building in defence industry.

TFTC delivers a structured program that provides mentee women working across STEM functions with access to their own defence industry mentor for 12 months. More than 400 mentees representing more than 25 organisations have participated in the program.

Leading Well, an organisation specialising in leadership, business coaching, and mentoring programs, delivers the program's formal training.

PROGRAM COMMITMENT

- Complete the application form and 30-minute phone interview.
- Dedicate~1 hour a month for one-on-one mentoring sessions.
- Attend the 1/2 day induction & launch session in September.
- Attend three 2-3hr quarterly in-person meetings in November, March, and June.
- Arrange any necessary travel to sessions.

- · Have at least FIVE years of experience post-completing tertiary education.
- · Have at least THREE years of experience within the defence industry.
- Hold an industry gualification.
- Have the skill and experience to guide a mentee.
