## PROUDLY EMPOWERING WOMEN IN DEFENCE INDUSTRY

Developed in 2015, The Future Through Collaboration (TFTC) Mentoring Program is an award-winning, industry-lead, **not-for-profit** initiative designed to support the professional development and capacity building of women in defence industry.

TFTC delivers a structured program that provides mentee women working across STEM functions with access to their own defence industry mentor for a period of 12 months. More than 350 mentees have participated in the program representing more than 30 different organisations.

## THE COMMITMENT

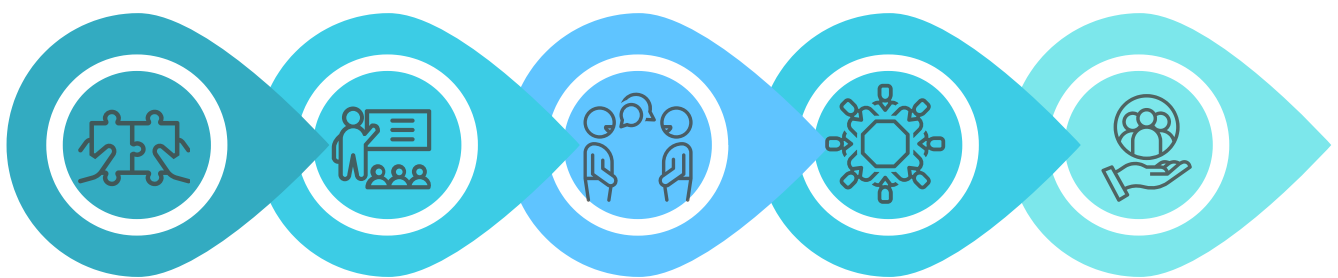
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- \$4,400 per pair - \$1,540 for a mentor; \$2,860 for a mentee (**excl. travel**).
- ~30 hours over 12 months.
- Applications for the 2025 program are open from 28th April 2025 - 30th May 2025.
- The 2025 program launches on August 28th, 2025, in Canberra, ACT, and officially ends on August 28th, 2026.

# FORMAL MENTORING OPPORTUNITIES

## HOW THE PROGRAM WORKS

All mentees and mentors participate in an induction training session to ensure that they get the most out of the program. Mentee and mentor pairs meet monthly one-on-one and also attend quarterly facilitated peer group training sessions to support their ongoing success. The program's formal training is delivered by Leading Well, an organisation specialising in leadership, business coaching and mentoring programs.



### MATCHING

Participants complete application forms. Pairs are matched based on their applications

### INDUCTIONS

Induction training for both mentors and mentees to outline details and objectives of the program

### MEET UPS

Monthly meetings between pairs. If matched pairs are located in different cities, meetings to be via phone or online

### QUARTERLY SESSIONS

Quarterly facilitated sessions encourage learning and best practice to work through challenges

### ONGOING SUPPORT

Ongoing support provided by the TFTC Program Specialist
